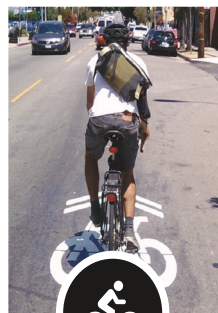

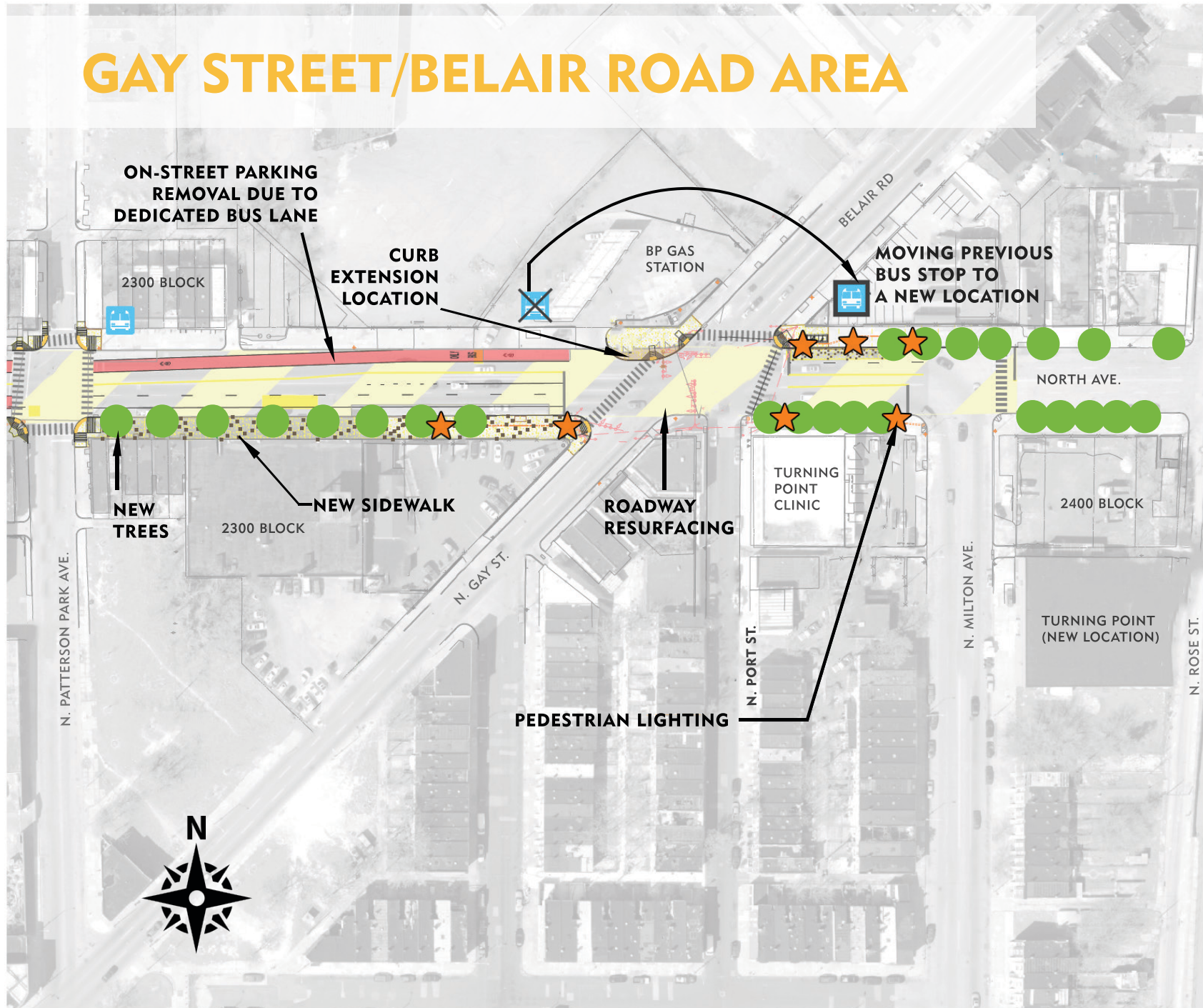

WHAT DOES **STREETSCAPING** MEAN?

A “streetscape” is the space between the road curb and the end of the sidewalk.

This project proposes to install new **sidewalks, pedestrian lighting, trees, and ADA-accessible sidewalk curb ramps and extensions** to make North Avenue safer and more visually appealing.

Four areas were selected for streetscaping because they have a high number of businesses and pedestrians. Construction would occur from **late 2019 to late 2021** and streetscaping areas would include:

- WALBROOK JUNCTION
- FULTON AVENUE
- PENNSYLVANIA AVENUE
- GREENMOUNT AVENUE
- GAY STREET/BELAIR ROAD**
