Since our last public meeting in June, where we reviewed the 35% plans, our project team has been all over the North Avenue corridor bringing project information to many events and community organizations. Looking ahead to the fall, we are excited to announce the dates and locations for two upcoming public meetings at which we will provide updates on the 90% plans as the project advances toward completion.

As always, these meetings are an opportunity to work directly with project staff and neighbors to continue advancing the general concepts we've discussed at our previous public meetings in November 2017, February 2018, and most recently, June 2018. These meetings are also the last opportunity to comment on proposed plans before beginning the procurement and construction processes in 2019.

North Avenue Rising is a joint project by the Maryland Department of Transportation Maryland Transit Administration (MDOT MTA) and the Baltimore City Department of Transportation (BCDOT) to invest in transportation infrastructure on the North Avenue corridor between Hilton Street and Milton Avenue.

The revitalization effort includes dedicated bus lanes and transit signal priority to improve transit reliability with targeted streetscaping, sidewalk investments, roadway repaving, improved pedestrian crossings, and upgrades to the Penn-North Metro SubwayLink Station.
