

NORTH AVENUE RISING

Bus Lanes and Repaving (east side)



Work Hours for Lane Closures are 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Work generally takes place Monday to Friday, but also on some Saturdays

Schedule is subject to change due to weather or unforeseen conditions

October 19 – Removal of top-layer of asphalt for non-bus lanes, from Guilford to Aisquith and from Washington to Milton.

Early November – Repaving of non-bus lanes from Guilford to Aisquith and Washington to Milton, with some adjustments for other projects.

Mid- to Late November - Removal of the top-layer of asphalt and repaving for the **bus lanes** will start at Guilford and go all the way to Gay/Belair and back.



Enforcement will begin after BUS LANE signs and BUS ONLY markings have been installed along all of east North Avenue, probably in **Spring 2021**.



Installation of **BUS LANE** signs and **BUS ONLY** roadway markings will start, first eastbound and then westbound *when weather allows*.

Eastbound – Greenmount to Aisquith

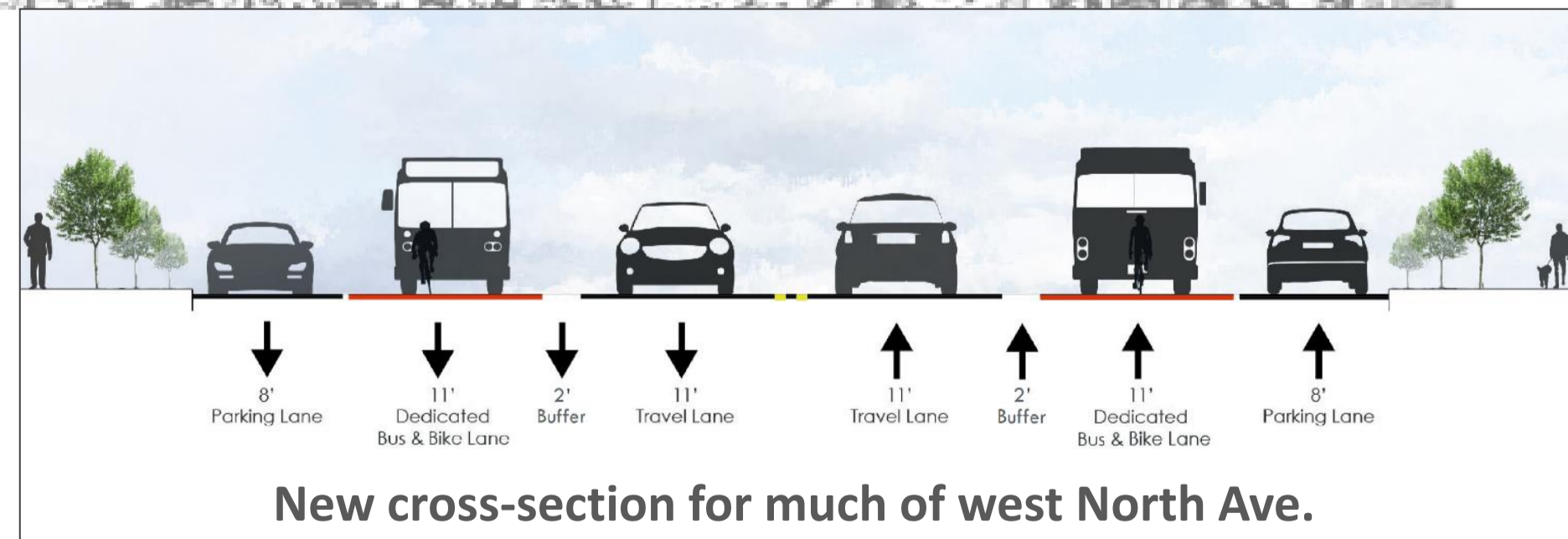
Westbound – Gay/Belair to Harford
